<b>Jan</b> 2,3,4	snow, snap or sugar peas
6 <sup>th</sup>	pepper seeds into flats
11,12,13,14	leaf crops into flats or ground early batch of tomatoes in flats *
18 <sup>th</sup>	transplant
28,29	sunflowers into containers
29,30,31	green onions and snow, snap or sugar peas into the ground
<b>Feb</b> 3,4,5	root crops radishes, potatoes, beets, turnips *
7,8,9,10	leaf crops especially greens and tomatoes into flats
17, 18	transplants
24, 25	sunflowers
26, 27	snap, sugar, snow peas * Plant fruit trees
<b>Mar</b> 3, 4	root crops beets, carrots, radishes potatoes *
7,8, 9	leaf crops squashes, beans, greens
17, 18	transplants
24	sunflowers into the ground
25, 26	snow, snap or sugar peas *
30, 31	root crops beets, turnips, radishes and potatoes
<b>Apr</b> 3,4,5	transplant tomatoes into the ground*
13, 14	transplant and leaf crops of squashes, okra, melons and beans
21,22,23	transplant tomatoes
26,27	root crops
<b>May</b> 1,2,3	Black-eyed peas, crowder peas
10,11	Leaf crops seed in beans, squash, melons, okra
17,18	sunflowers into the ground
20	tomato transplants into the ground*
23,24,25	root crops
28,29,30	Black- eyed peas, crowder peas
<b>Jun</b> 2,3	Transplants
6,7	Beans, melons squashes. Okra
14	sunflowers
15,16,17	transplant leaf crops
20,21	root crops last chance for radishes
24,25	black-eyed peas, crowder peas
