Tim Miller – Millberg Farm

July	
4	Leaf crops, melons, squash, cucumbers, okra, swiss chard and tomatoes into flats*
12,13	Leaf crops, melons, squash, okra, transplants of peppers, tomatoes, eggplant Malabar spinach
17, 18	Rather odd radish planting date for a really fast-growing variety.
21-24	Black eye peas
31	Leaf crops, chard, Jewels of opar, basil, beans and arugula
August	
1	Leaf crops of chard, basil and arugula
7,8,9	Leaf crops melons, squash, beans, cucumbers*
17-20	Transplant tomatoes into containers or ground
23,24,25	Root crops seed in carrots, beets, radish, turnips potatoes*
September	
5, 6	Leaf crops seed in spinach, beans, snap peas, collards, arugula lettuce
14, 15, 16	Transplant chard, tomatoes and peppers into ground
19	Transplant fruit trees into ground figs*
20 ,21	Root crops seed in carrots, beets, turnips, radishes and garlic.
24, 25	Seed in (sugar, snow or snap) peas*
October	
2, 3, 4	Leaf crops seed in lettuce, chard, spinach broccoli cabbage Silvery Fir Tree tomatoes for winter growing*
11-14	Transplant broccoli, cabbage chard
16-18	Root crops seed in beets, carrots turnips radish, garlic and green onion bulbs
22	Sugar snap peas*
30, 31	Leaf crops seed in flats broccoli, cabbage spinach
November	
3, 4, 5	Radishes and daikon, divide and replant multiplying onions
7-10	Leaf crops seed in spinach & lettuce transplant broccoli, cabbage, lettuce and spinach
13-15	Roots crops of carrots, beets and radishes
18	snap peas
26, 27	Leaf crops spinach, lettuce, arugula and collards
December	
5-7	Leaf crops seed in flats broccoli, cabbage and spinach
10-12	Root crops seed in beets, carrots and radishes
13, 14	Transplant in broccoli
15, 16	Plant sugar snap peas*
23, 24, 25	Transplant in broccoli, cabbage and chard.
